



GABL COACHES INFORMATION

General Information

Volunteer coaches are the foundation of GABL. Without them, the league cannot exist. It is necessary, however, for the league to do all that it can to ensure that coaches are properly trained and can appropriately handle young players.

In order to be considered to be a coach in the GABL winter program, head or assistant, an individual must complete the enclosed application form and be approved by the Board of Directors. **Head coaches must be approved on an annual basis.**

Responsibilities of GABL Coaches

- ⇒ Complete a coach application on an annual basis.
- ⇒ Teach sportsmanship to participants, fans and parents.
- ⇒ Review and discuss all league rules with players and parents.
- ⇒ Obtain sponsorship for the team or coordinate sufficient fundraising efforts to cover sponsor fees, uniform and equipment cost.
- ⇒ Properly supervise all practice sessions and use of gymnasiums.
- ⇒ Provide a scorekeeper or timekeeper for each game and ensure that each is properly trained.
- ⇒ Approve the accuracy of the official scoresheets of all games.
- ⇒ The conduct of the players, coaching staff and fans during the game.
- ⇒ Select assistant coaches who exercise good sportsmanship, uphold all league rules, comply with the GABL Coaches' Code of Conduct, and complete a coach application form.
- ⇒ Attend all required meetings and clinics.
- ⇒ Ensure that all players on the team have submitted registration form and paid appropriate fees.

GENERAL REGISTRATION INFORMATION

General registration material for the winter program will be sent after school starts. Team and individual sign-ups will take place through September 30 on-line, by mail, fax or walk-in to the league office during regular business hours (Monday through Friday, 9am-5pm). Coaches may register their entire team.

2009-10 GABL BOYS WINTER PROGRAM

Team formation policies for grades 2 through 8 for the 2009-10 winter season are summarized below. All team formations, including teams registered by a coach, are subject to final approval by the competition committee; **any exceptions from these policies below must be approved by the GABL.**

POLICIES FOR 2ND ADVANCED-8TH GRADE

- General. **NEW IN 2009-10!** There are no geographical restrictions on team formation. PLEASE NOTE: In order to use school district facilities for practice, teams **must** have 75 percent of their participants from the district in which they want to practice.
- Preformed Teams. Approved coaches may register an entire team provided they have a minimum of 8 players.
- Individual Registrations. 3rd through 8th grade players who do not register with a team will be assigned to available teams or new teams formed, provided there are enough volunteer coaches.
- **Participants may not play on more than one GABL team, regardless of level of play.**

Second, Third and Fourth Grades

- 2nd Grade Advanced. Individual registrations are not accepted for the 2nd grade advanced league. Entry is by team only. Second graders registering individually must play in the 3-on-3 development program.
- Uniforms. Jerseys are provided by the league and **must be worn during all games.**

Fifth through Eighth Grades

- Level of Play. Coaches registering an entire team shall indicate the level of play at which they will enter (Select A, A or B). Select A and A are competitive divisions and B is a recreational division. The grade director will make the final determination of the level of play based on previous year's results, preseason tournament results and preseason games.
- Releases. All players are considered released at the conclusion of the previous winter basketball league. It is suggested that a returning coach notify players and parents/guardians from the previous year's team to explain the coach's plan for team formation in the upcoming winter season.

2009-10 BOYS WINTER LEAGUE TEAM FEE

Payment of a \$250 team fee for the 2009-10 winter season for boys teams in 3rd grade through 8th grade is required. It is recommended that each team secure a local business to pay the \$250 team fee and thus become a GABL Bronze Business Partner. In the event the team cannot secure a sponsor, the fee must be divided between the players. **The fee for preformed teams is due at registration unless alternative arrangements are made. If alternative arrangements are made, the fee MUST BE PAID no later than November 1.**

The benefits of a Bronze Business Partner include (1) Sponsor Recognition Plaque [team must have picture taken by the official photographer to receive this plaque]; (2) Listing on GABL website page for sponsors; and (3) Options to participate in additional GABL advertising and promotion opportunities. This category allows smaller businesses to support the league and its activities.

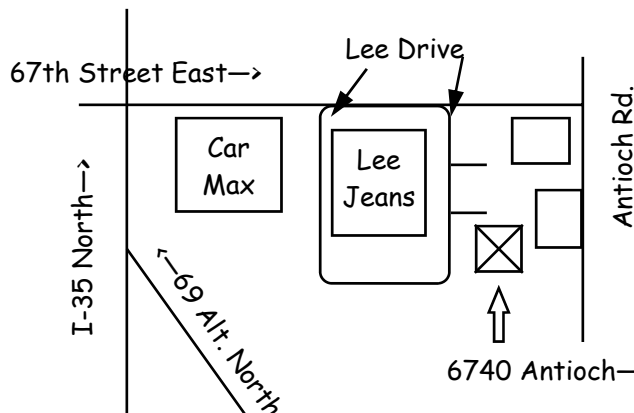
